Applications may be submitted at any time. All applications received by December 31 will be considered for the following year's docent season. You will receive notification of whether you have been selected to serve as a volunteer during the next park season after the docent committee's Winter meeting. Any volunteers who are not selected to be part of the Lighthouse Docent program will be encouraged to volunteer at FORI's other events and will be offered the opportunity to be included on the Lighthouse Docent alternate list.
